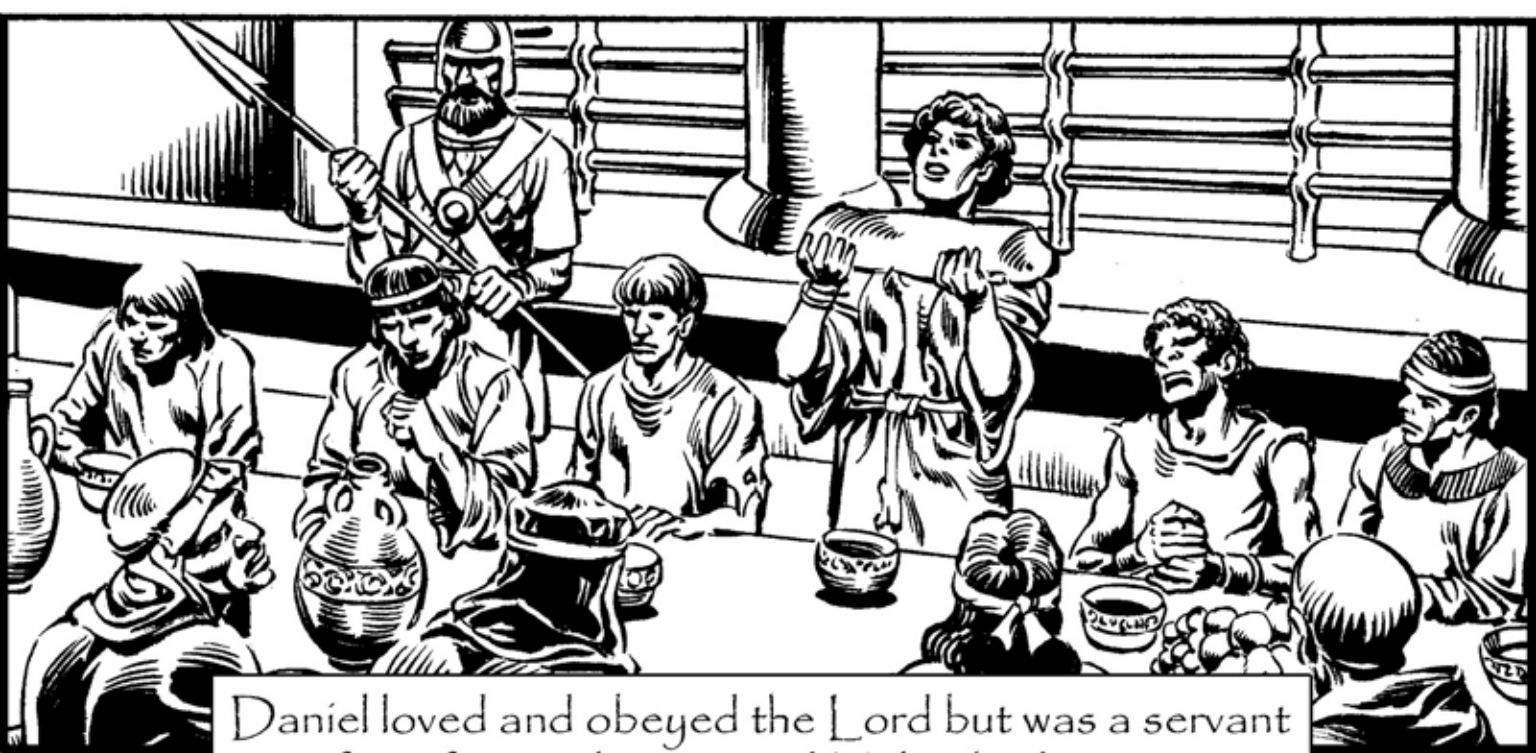


Lesson 8

& the Dream

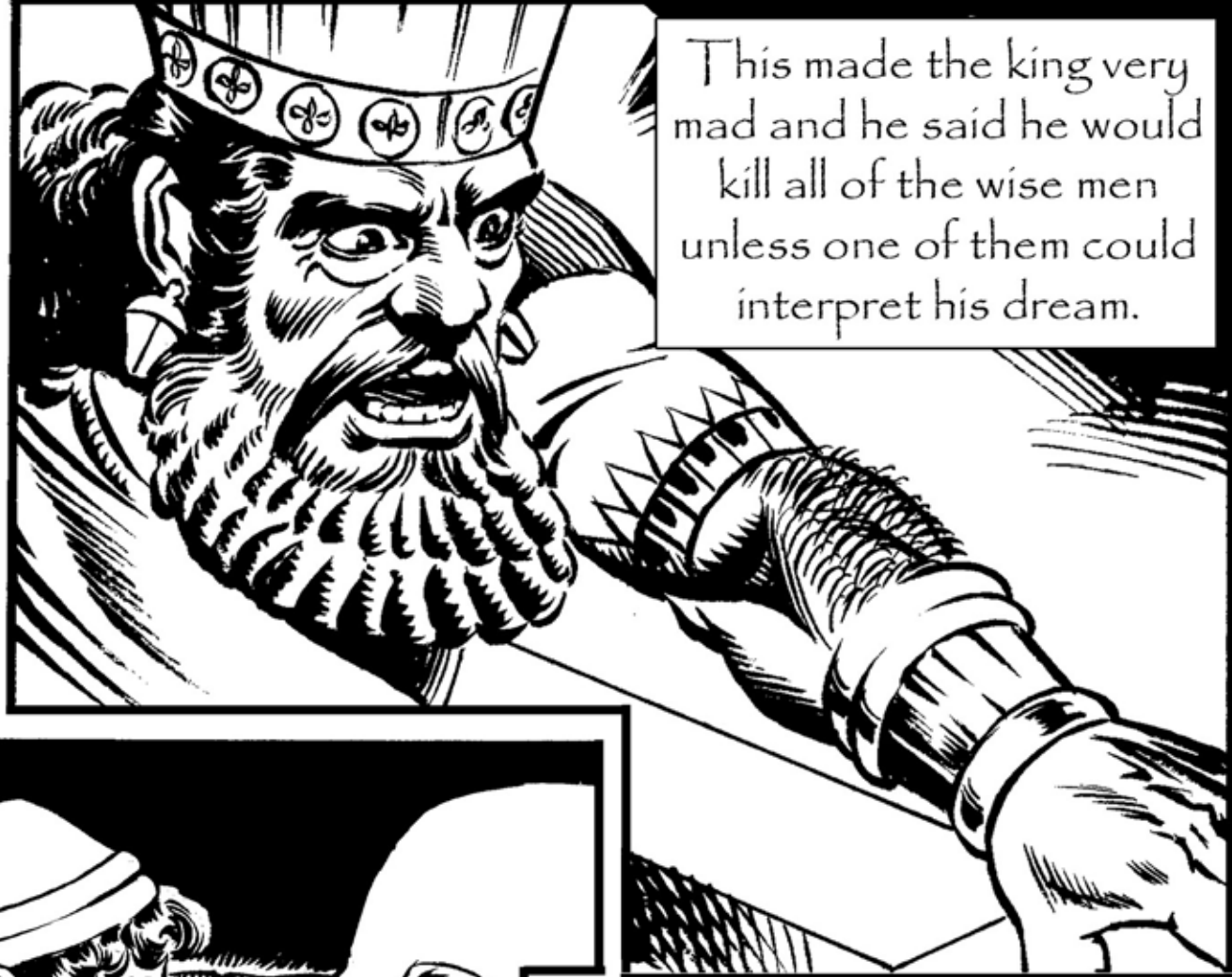


Daniel loved and obeyed the Lord but was a servant for a foreign king named Nebuchadnezzar.

Daniel went before Nebuchadnezzar and told him that God had given him wisdom to interpret the king's dream.

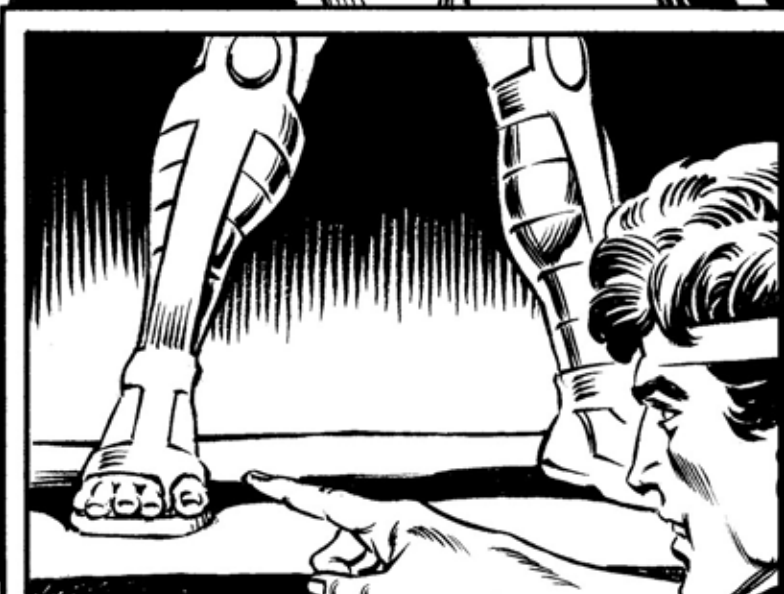
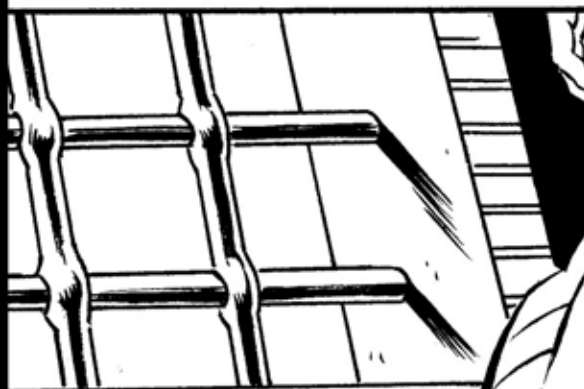




Daniel began telling the king the meaning of his dream. "There was a great image whose head was made of gold. You, O King, are the head of gold."
